- A. Seek mutual advice and support in planning and executing programs, promoting excellence in respective areas of theatrical activities and education.
- B. Assist in student, teacher training regarding drama, theatre and other cultural activities.
- C. Share the library and literature facilities mutually by giving access to library and other resources of either institute to the student, research personnel of other institute.
- D. Period of Agreement: this MoU shall remain in force for five years from the date of the last signature. Prior to the expiration date, this agreement maybe reviewed for possible renewal for a further five years period. Either party may terminate this MoU by providing 60 days advance writing notice to the other party.
- E. It is expected that activities taking place under this agreement will be initiated primarily in coordination with their respective administrative units concerned with such activities. All activities undertaken must confirm to the policies and procedures in place at each institution.
- F. Any and all disputes or differences arising out of or in connection with this MoU or its performance shall, so far as it is possible, be settling by negotiation between the parties amicably through consultation and understanding.
