The legacy of this organization is continued by Padmashri's worthy son Dr. Balasaheb Vikhe Patil (Padmbhushan Awadree). PMT has been providing quality services to the poor and underprivileged populations in drought-prone, backward areas of this region.

Arts, Commerce and Science College Shevgaon was established in 2013-14. The college operates on a non-grant basis and is affiliated with Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune. The college offers 02 undergraduate programs in Science from 2013-14 and from Academic Year 2017-18 an undergraduate programme in Arts and Commerce and is added.
